Dear mr. Lang and MUFON staff for North Carolina.

Let me introduce to you myself. I am Giuliano Marinkovic, investigative journalist from Croatian National Television. I am currently working on a case with a fellow researchers about caller Bob that called on air to popular radio show Coast to Coast AM on February 3rd. I don't know are you familiar with the case. This is what we now so far about caller Bob. We don't have much data, only some analytical speculation.

The name-nick of the guy: Bob (Robert)

Home location: Fayetteville, North Carolina

Bob has said that he is in the army and he is monitoring satellite cameras. He probably works in Fort-Bragg and he is probably involved with the unit where satellite cameras are monitored. Bob probably monitors world-wide weather data for shipping, air transport, and troop movements. We are trying to find any researcher or military buff who is knowledgeable about units in Fort-Bragg and that could point us in to the right direction how we could continue our search to locate mr. Bob. I am hoping that you will be able to recommend someone from your MUFON team in North Carolina and Fayetteville who is knowledgeable about Fort-Bragg – or any other info that could help although it is a long shoot.

Any lead will be greatly appreciated.
